SKATEBOARD MUSIC INSTRUMENT

Skatesonic is a techno-territorialization of skateboard-culture. This uniquely augmented thrill-transmitter (skateboard) is a new musical controller/toy. The system tracks the 3D-movement of the skateboard via bluetooth. Movement is analyzed and turned into musical fantasy. Riding waves of chaotic timing, implying temporary control of what is temporal. The composer creates a system to be experienced rather than a final piece of music. Each move translates into musical parameters & the riders end up skating through a landscape of sound.

SKATESONIC will open with a spectacular performance by skaters from the Bay Area and flow into a free improvisation/play space. 4 boards, each board mapping to unique sounds. 4 riders jam like a band—their slick moves sound in space.
